His Master's Voice is not a drop-off program. All students are expected to be accompanied by their parent, guardian, or an adult that has agreed to serve as their parent-proxy. If there is a person serving as parent-proxy for your student, you need to notify HMV of this. If anything happens to or involving your child while they are here, we HAVE TO KNOW who is responsible for that child. If your student is 18 or older, they can be responsible for themselves if you notify us that it is your choice-- but they may not be considered responsible for other students. Students are not to leave the church property to get food or explore the area unless it is with YOU.

There is a kitchen area, with sink and microwave- no stovetop or oven. You are welcome to use those facilities, IF you clean up after yourself. **Bring your own dishes/paper/plasticware.**

The Board will, as much as possible, provide coffee to be made in the church coffee maker, sugar, and powdered creamer. We also normally have at least a few styrofoam cups for those that forget to bring their own-- but the church coffee supplies are not for our use. There is a refrigerator, but it is often packed full- depending upon the church's activities and events.

There are vending machines with sodas and snacks, and many local businesses in the area that have DoorDash and GrubHub delivery options.
