Other possible performance times will be announced as they are scheduled and could include but are not limited to: Homeschool Day at the Capitol, Harvest Festival, Senior Center and fundraising opportunities.

Class Policies:

- Waiver and Release of Liability form parental signature required to protect the church from lawsuits.
- No weapons, alcohol, illegal drugs or tobacco products allowed on the church property.
- No stealing or defacing of church property.
- HMV shirts are required for classes and concerts. Students must be neat, dressed modestly and appropriately. No mini skirts or short shorts- all attire should extend to at least mid-thigh for men and women. If a student's pants are in the "distressed style" and seem to us to have more holes than fabric- or are in any other way inappropriate, we may ask the student to change. We would much rather that you, the parents *police* your student than for us to have to get involved.
- Students must conduct themselves responsibly: No disrespect shown to the Directors, parents, church staff, or other students.
- If students are not in class they are to stay in the Fellowship Hall, no wandering in or distracting other classes allowed. Students should not be in any room in which they do not have a class without permission.
- Students may not detract from the group as a whole with unusual hair styles or with body piercings (other than ladies' ears).
- No Public displays of affection for students between non-family members of the opposite sex or same sex. No hand-holding, cuddling, kissing, or extended-length hugs.

- No electronic devices shall be used during class time. In an emergency, contact the board directly.
- Students will be responsible for the required materials for each class according to the class syllabus.
- Students are expected to have and bring their music stand to all appropriate classes and performances
- Students/Parents should advise their teachers if they are going to be absent from class.
- No eating or drinking in the classrooms; only in the designated lunch room.
 *****Students and parents are expected to clean up their own lunch and table in the fellowship hall.
 If it is untidy, other parents have to stay and clean it up before we can go home.
- We are very thankful for our facility and the graciousness of Trinity Chapel. Please do your part to always leave Trinity Chapel clean and uncluttered.

His Master's Voice is not a drop-off program. All students are expected to be accompanied by their parent, guardian, or an adult that has agreed to serve as their parent-proxy. If there is a person serving as parent-proxy for your student, you need to notify HMV of this. If anything happens to or involving your child while they are here, we HAVE TO KNOW who is responsible for that child. If your student is 18 or older, they can be responsible for themself if you notify us that it is your choice—but they may not be considered responsible for other students. Students are not to leave the church property to get food or explore the area unless it is with YOU.

There is a kitchen area, with sink and microwave- no stovetop or oven. You are welcome to use those facilities, IF you clean up after yourself. **Bring your own dishes/paper/plasticware.**

The Board will, as much as possible, provide coffee to be made in the church coffee maker, sugar, and powdered creamer. We also normally have at least a few styrofoam cups for those that forget to bring their own—but the church coffee supplies are not for our use. There is a refrigerator, but it is often packed full-depending upon the church's activities and events.

There are vending machines with sodas and snacks, and many local businesses in the area that have DoorDash and GrubHub delivery options.
